

Making a change to your will (England & Wales)

Each form you complete must be signed in the presence of two witnesses who both need to sign the form in the relevant places. These witnesses cannot be direct family members (this includes spouse/civil partner) or anyone who stands to benefit from the codicil. Keep this form safe, but do not attach it in any way to your will.

We recommend you get advice and guidance from a solicitor when you make your will or codicil so that your wishes can be fully met.
